- Registered allied health professionals who are in clinical leadership roles with local, system-wide or regional visibility

For example, you may be in a uni-professional leadership role with connections across health, education and social care or really well known in your locality in your role in service improvement and innovations **OR** you may be a chief AHP **OR** pan-professional lead **OR** a visible leader in one of the allied health professions that are smaller in number than the therapies.
- We are looking for membership to include AHPs from a range of clinical areas including mental health, physical health, acute, community, social care, education settings and those who have influence and reach in independent settings too.

The National Children's Bureau is supporting NHS England to scope and establish this network. NCB will share data from the Expressions of Interest form with NHS England to enable the sustainability of the network.
