The University of Derby offers the following apprenticeships in Prosthetics and Orthotics:

#### Level 3 Prosthetic & Orthotic Technician Apprenticeship

- 12–18-month course (12 months of course delivery and 6 months EPA period)
- Three days of teaching on campus
- Non-integrated End Point Assessment (EPA)
- Can be used as an entry course for Level 6

#### Level 6 BSc degree for Prosthetists & Orthotists Apprenticeship



Funding

training costs from the department budget.

#### 36-month course

- One week per year of teaching on campus
- Integrated End Point Assessment (EPA)
- Eligible for HCPC registration on completion

Both apprenticeship courses are funded through the Growth and Skills Levy when

The structure and delivery of the non-apprenticeship courses mirror the apprenticeship
