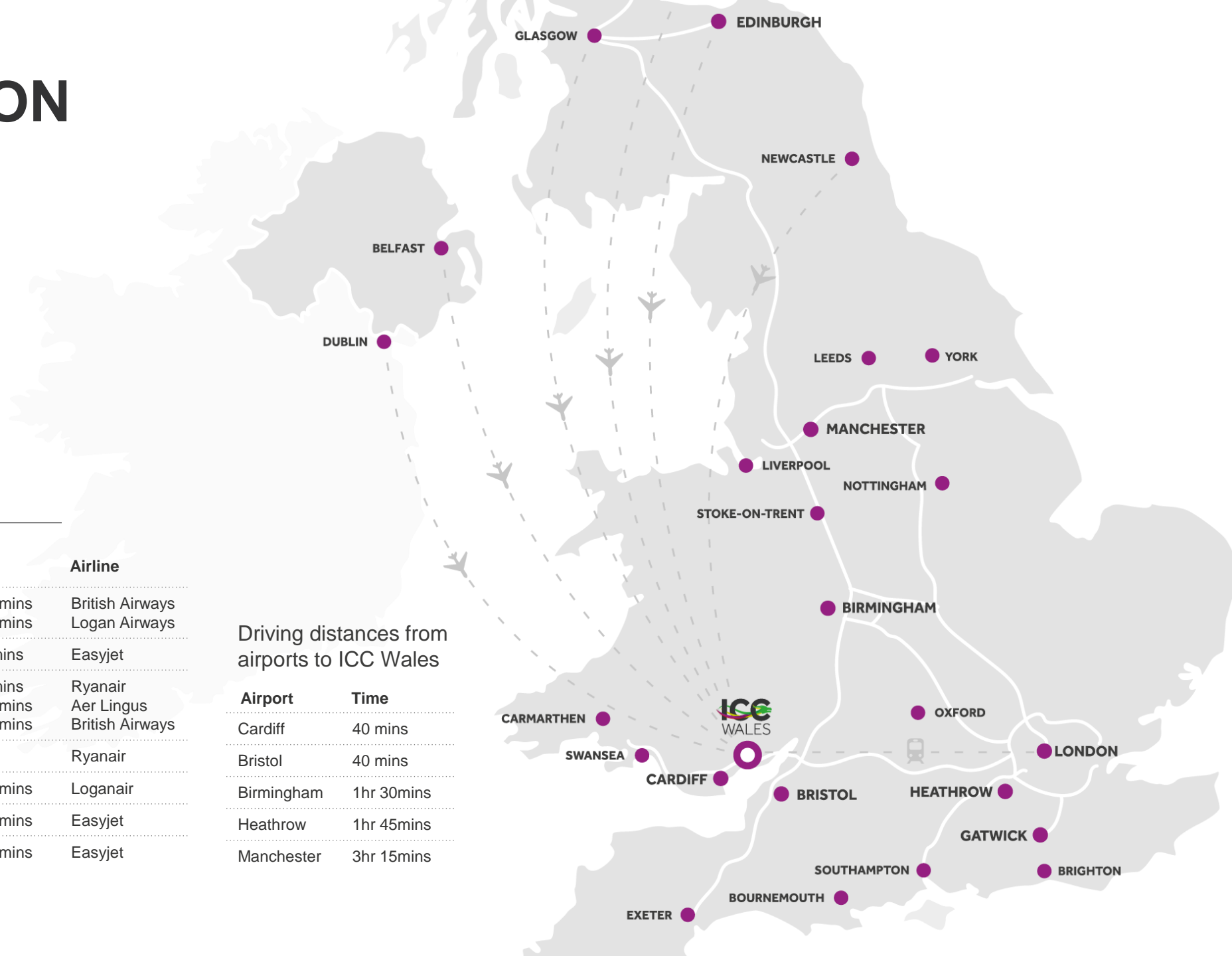

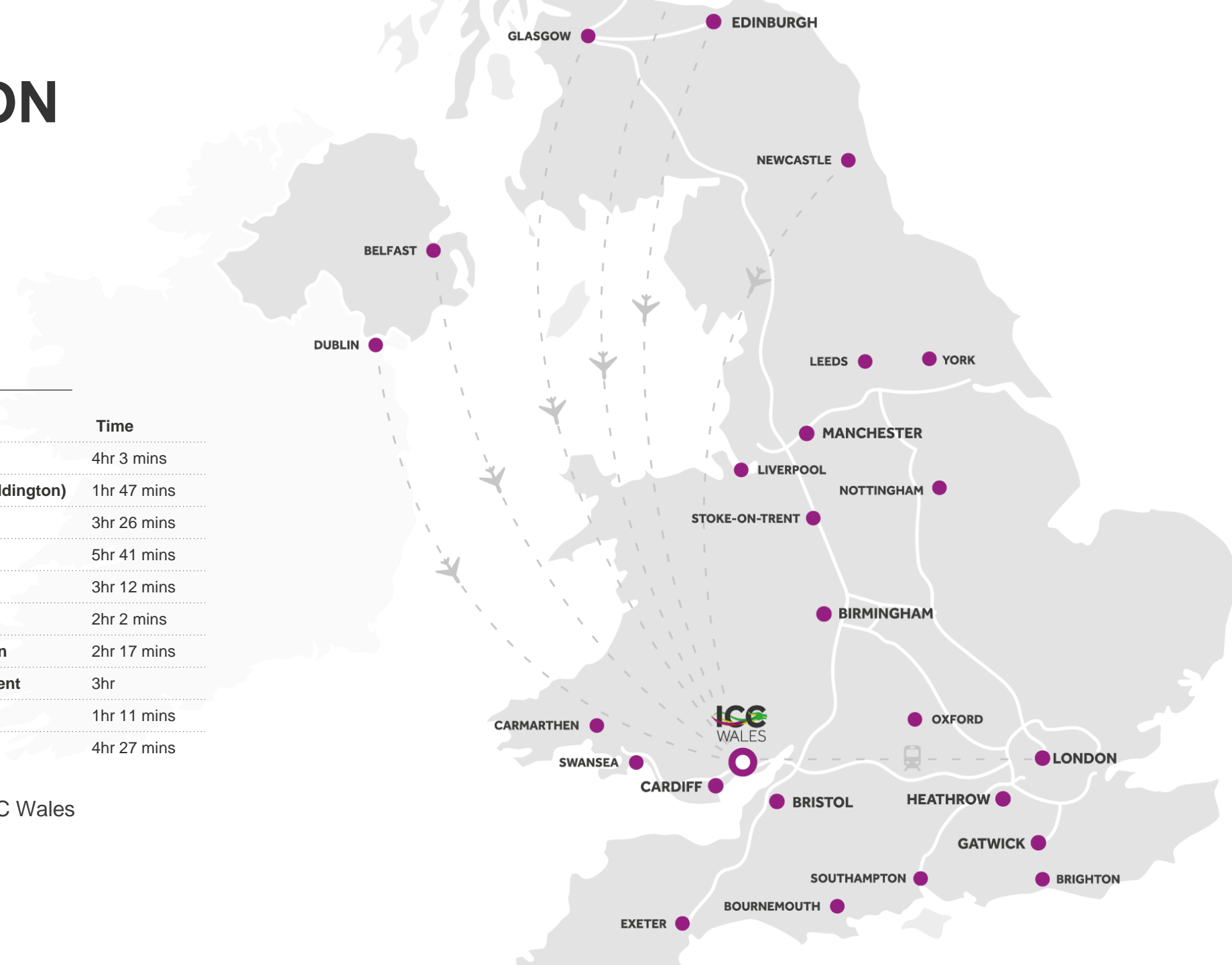

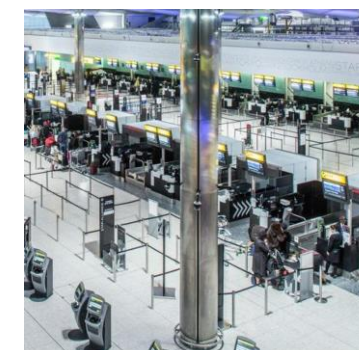

## From **Cardiff International Airport**

---

### Option 1

Cardiff Airport 304 bus to Barry Train Station **17 minutes**

Train from Barry to Cardiff Central **6 minutes**

Train from Cardiff Central to Newport **12 minutes**

Taxi or Bus from Newport station to ICC Wales **12 minutes**

### Option 2

Taxi from Cardiff Airport to ICC Wales: 33 minutes and approx.  
**£70.00 for up to 4 passengers**

## From **Bristol International Airport**

---

### Option 1

Bristol Airport Flyer bus to Bristol Train Station **11 minutes**

Train from Templemeads to Newport station **1hr 33 minutes**

Taxi or Bus from Newport station to ICC Wales **12 minutes**

### Option 2

Bristol Airport Flyer bus to Bristol Bus Station **59 minutes**

Walk from Bristol Bus station to Bond Street Bristol **7 minutes**

Transporabus 925 from Bond Street Bristol to ICC Wales **40 minutes**

### Option 3

Taxi from Bristol Airport to ICC Wales: 43 minutes and approx.  
**£85.00 for up to 4 passengers**

## Travel by **train**

---

Newport is the third busiest station in Wales with direct trains from a large number of UK cities.

12 mins drive away from ICC Wales.

Direct routes.

Discounted GWR delegate travel from London to Newport.

## Travel by **car**

---

700 underground car parking spaces with direct access to the atrium of ICC Wales (charges apply).

Ample blue badge parking spaces available on both car park levels.

EV charging points available on -1 level.

No bridge toll travelling from England to Wales.

Easy access to the ICC Wales from the M50 and M4 (J24).

## Travel by **bus**

---

Newport City has 33 electric buses within its fleet, which can be utilised to keep all areas of the City easily connected.

We recommend using Newport Bus Journey Planner – adding a start and finishing location to provide the best journey option. The bus stop closest to the ICC Wales is called 'Celtic Manor'. The service that stops in this area is the number 73 although other services are available in walking distance.

From Bristol we recommend using the Transporabus 925 from Bond Street Bristol directly to ICC Wales.

## Travel by **taxi**

---

Priority services and streamlined booking process with partnership taxi firms, Dragon Taxis and Hackney Carriages.

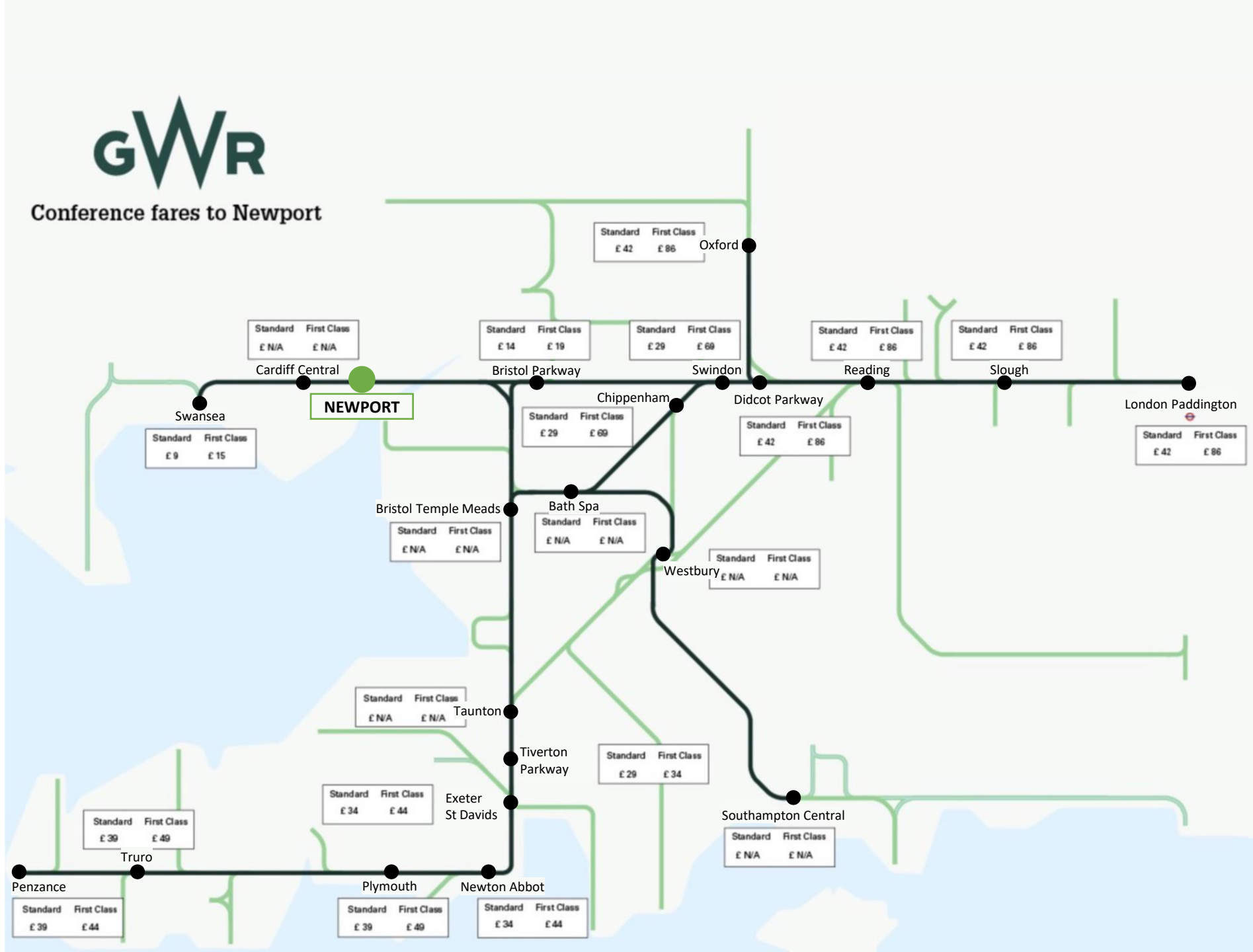
# DELEGATE TRAINS

This map shows sample conference fares to Newport, Conference fares are available from most stations on the GWR network, not just those shown on the map. Exclusions include stations which are quite close to the conference, or on routes which are predominately served by other operators. Tickets are only valid on GWR services. Check the GWR website for fares from other stations.

Outbound tickets are fixed, times and dates cannot be changes. The return journey is fully flexible. These conference fares are only available to delegates. You will be asked to produce conference confirmation by the Train Manager.
