Tracey Samuel-Smith, HCPC Education Manager explains `Lead visitors are responsible for providing their professional expertise to the assessment of existing and proposed education and training programmes delivered by education providers. They make a real difference to the work we do and how we help to protect the public. This is a fantastic opportunity to get involved and help safeguard people using our registrants services by ensuring education and training programmes meet our standards.

Lead visitors must meet the criteria set out in the Information for Applicants. You must be registered and should have an understanding of the principles of quality assurance in Higher/Further Education or in a practice environment, as well as teaching, learning and assessment strategies in an educational or practice environment. In particular we invite those who are currently experienced in supervising learners in their current workplace to apply for this role.

We pay a rate of £82 for profession specific advice for a review plus a daily fee of £206 for approval process stage and performance review assessments.

We expect visitors to commit to around five days per year. The length and notice for providing services are variable and can fit most diary commitments and working patterns. If you are successful, you will be required to undertake mandatory training prior to commencing your role.

All partners must have the right to work in the United Kingdom (UK) and reside in the country.
