This role is for an Orthotist within the NHSGGC Orthotics Team.

This post is fixed term for 5 months.

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The service is responsible for the delivery of outpatient and inpatient Orthotic care to all adults living within the in NHSGGC catchment area. We also deliver care to inpatients who do not reside within NHSGGC and who receive treatment at our national and regional inpatient services. We deliver outpatient and inpatient care to Children and Young People in Clyde Sector. We provide service on 8 acute sites and to other outlying units on demand.

We aim to deliver a timely, high quality, patient centred service to all our service users in line with NHSGGC's quality aims and the Quality Strategy. We use the evidence wherever possible to ensure we are delivering the most up to date care for our patients.

Essential criteria are:

- Honours Degree in Prosthetics and Orthotics or equivalent
- Current HCPC Registration (unless a recent graduate awaiting registration)
- Evidence of relevant post graduate CPD at Level 5 on the NMAHP Career Development Framework.
